COVES PROJECT

Through Art Bridges, the Collaboration for Ongoing Visitor Experience Studies (COVES) is designed to unite museums across the country to systematically collect, analyze, and report on visitor experience data. Information will be gathered through a survey created by Art Bridges and conducted at randomized times throughout the week by a team of volunteers who will be stationed with an iPad near the entrances and exits. We will be conducting training throughout March 2024 with the intention to start conducting surveys beginning in April 2024.
